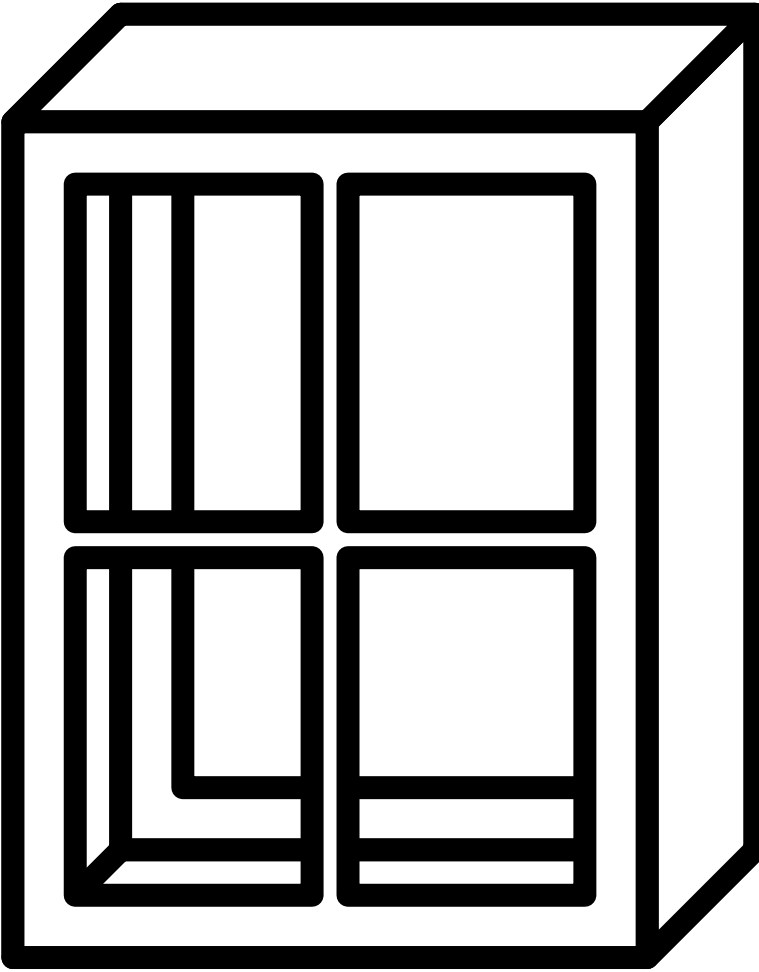


B. Cut out 5 holes in the large areas

II. Cut out one large rectangle for the back hole

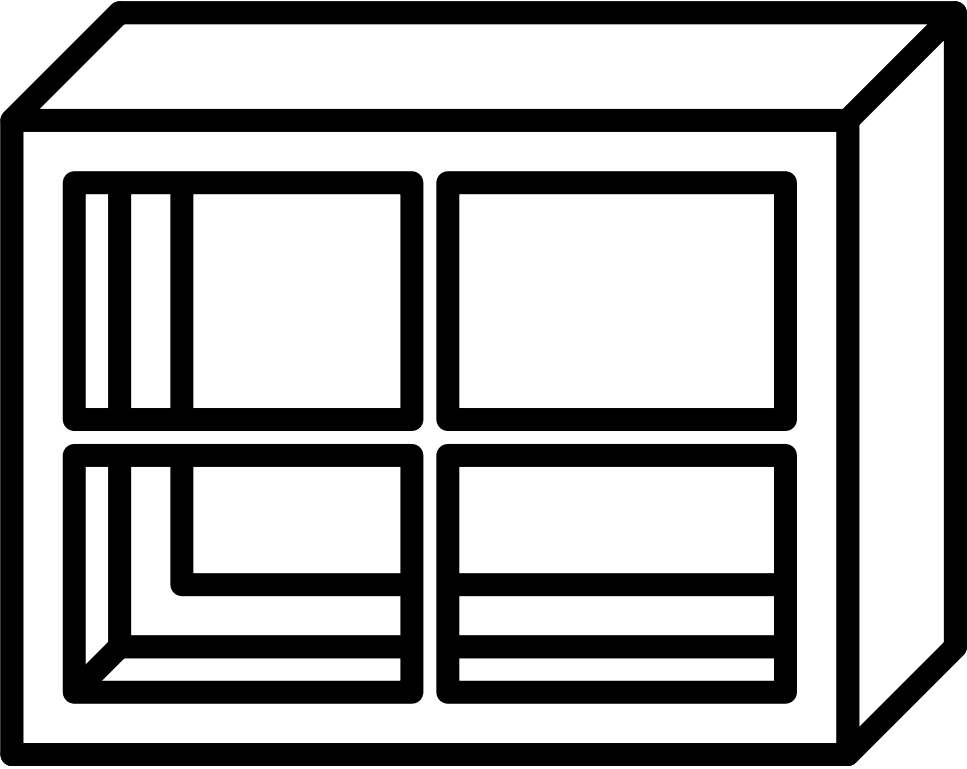


C. You now have a cereal box with 5 holes

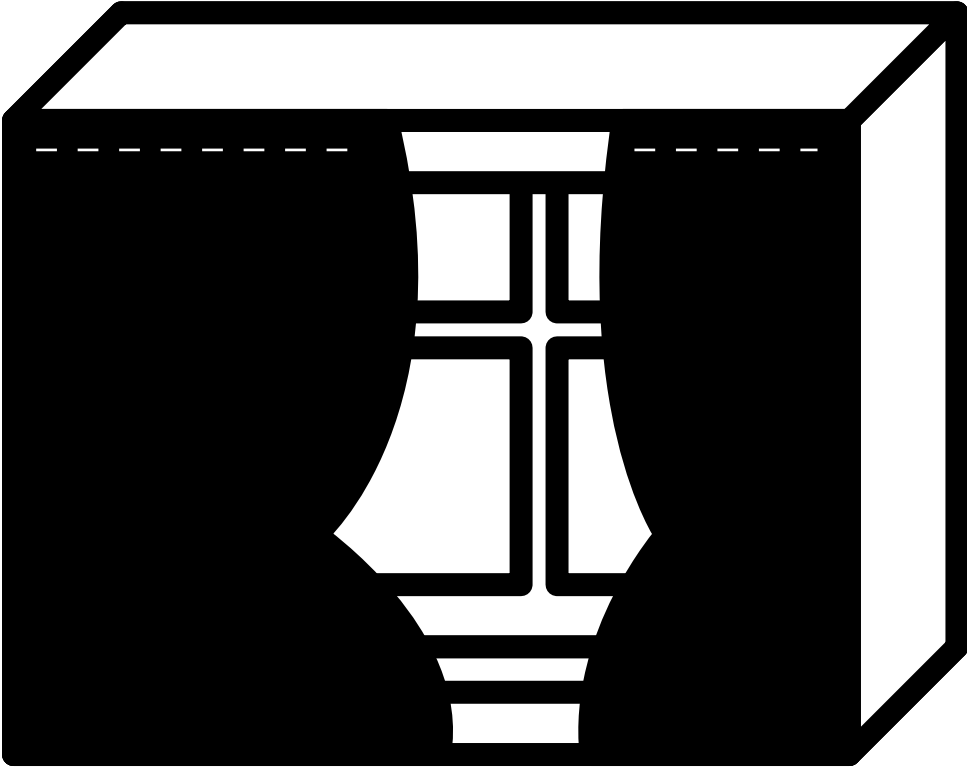
D. Glue the cereal box back together
